

## Village of Goehner

April 7, 2026

The Village of Goehner Board of Trustees met in open session and regular session on April 7, 2026, at the Goehner Fire Hall, as posted in three places in the Village. Chairperson Knisley announced the location of the OPEN MEETINGS ACT POSTER. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Knisley at 7:30 p.m., at the Goehner Fire Hall. Upon roll call, the following board members were present: Agena, Anthony, Ostrander, Bialas and Knisley.

**CONSENT AGENDA:** Minutes of 3/3/2026; Treasurer's Report; Bills payable to date. Trustee Ostrander moved to approve the consent agenda, with a second by Trustee Agena. No discussion. RCV: Aye - Trustees Agena, Anthony, Ostrander, Bialas and Knisley. Motion Carried.

**Kaely Eberspacher:** Kaely was in attendance to introduce herself to the Trustee's. Kaely is running for County Commissioner District 3. Kaely has two years on the planning commission with Beaver Crossing, and is a current trustee with Beaver Crossing.

**Zoning Inspector Report** – None

**Nuisance properties** –1041May Street

- Lawyer has been contacted to proceed with getting judges affidavit to enter property for asbestos inspection.

**Traffic Report** – County Sheriff emailed to Trustee's.

**Solid Waste/Recycling** – There are changes to interlocal agreement, will be doing away with the weighted votes. New votes will be Cities of Seward and Crete get two votes, Seward and Saline county will get two votes all other entities get one vote. They are looking at distributing \$3000 to each entity in interlocal agreement. Discussion on what Village of Goehnr would like to request money for. Look into mulch of recycled materials under new park equipment. Next meeting June 25<sup>th</sup>.

**Street, Water, Sewer:**

- Discussion on the drag for road repairs. For a new drag all manual it will be \$20,000. For hydraulic drage is will be \$26,575. Trade in \$9000 on current drag. It will be \$3300 to add scarifier to current drag, that includes adding them to the drag and setting up the drag to correctly drag roads in the Village. Was decided to keep old drag and add scarifiers and see how things go.
- Hold over to next meeting quotes to repair parts of roads.
- Inspection of tank at wellhouse will be held off until a quote from Sargent
- Concrete bunkers for \$200, this will be used to add compost area at burn site. Bialas will look into ones that he could maybe get for free.
- Back up water operator Wayne Regnier current maintenance person at Garland and training person in Beaver Crossing will meet with Janice regarding assisting the Village and possibly taking over water operations in the Village.
- A thank you to NeRW for repair of 5 hydrants within the Village. They did this free of charge, village just had to purchase parts.
- Call NeRW to camera sewer behind Holy Cross Church.
