Permit is granted conditioned on compliance with all the ordinances of the Village of Goehner, Nebraska, and **payment \$25** for each demolition permit fee and payment by _____ of any damage or expense which may be incurred by the Village of Goehner, as a result of demolition.

_____ (Applicant) will be responsible to maintain some type of **barricades** around the location until the building and/or structure is completely demolished. If after demolition of the structure(s); it is found that a basement hole requires filling and the job is not completed within daylight hours, barricades will be put in place until the hole is cleared or debris are completely filled. If any damage is done to Village sidewalks, alleys, streets or utilities, such damage shall be repaired by the applicant.

A **deposit of \$500** is required from the applicant to ensure that the water service is **disconnected** from the water main along with the **capping** of the sewer line from sewer main. This work may be accomplished by Village crews or contractors. Village sewer line shall be capped at the property line. Village water service shall be disconnected at the Village main.

Street, Sewer and Water, departments of the Village of Goehner, and any other utilities (Cable, Telephone Co.,) will be **notified prior** to the actual demolition in order to ensure all meters or any other devices have been removed.

Streets and alleys that might be barricaded during the actual demolition will be cleared of debris and opened to normal traffic when work is completed each day.
