

VILLAGE OF GOEHNER

October 5, 2021

The Village of Goehner Board of Trustees met in open and regular session on October 5, 2021, at the Goehner Fire Hall, as posted in three places in the Village. Chairperson Knisley announced the location of the OPEN MEETINGS ACT POSTER. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Knisley at 7:30 p.m. Upon roll call, the following board members were present: Besse, Dodson, Ostrander and Knisley. Bialas arrived at 7:36. Absent: None.

CONSENT AGENDA: Minutes of 9/7/21; Treasurer's Report; Bills payable to date. Trustee Ostrander moved to approve the consent agenda, with second by Agena. No discussion. RCV: Aye-Trustee Ostrander, Agena, Bialas, Knisley. Abstain-Trustee Besse. Motion carried

STREET HEARING: The street hearing was opened at 7:40 and documents were available for review. No changes – Maintenance only.

STREET HEARING: Motion by Ostrander with second by Bialas to close the street hearing at 7:55. No discussion. RCV: Aye-Trustee Ostrander, Bialas, Besse, Agena, Knisley. Motion carried. Ostrander introduced Resolution 258 – One and Six Year Street plan with second by Bialas. No discussion. RCV: Aye-Trustee Ostrander, Bialas, Agena, Besse, Knisley. Motion carried. Ostrander introduced Resolution 259 – Signing of the Municipal Annual Certification of Program Compliance, moved by Bialas with second by Agena. No discussion. RCV: Aye-Trustee Bialas, Agena, Ostrander, Besse, Knisley. Motion carried.

Nuisance property – Svoboda property at 1230 May Street is still a problem. Attorney directed the board they would need to go through the Nuisance property steps again and send a letter to Svoboda giving a chance for a public hearing. Clerk to discuss with Attorney more.

Cattle Operation – waiting to hear back from Eberspacher's and their response to the letter sent in Sept.

Zoning – George presented building permit requests:
Leyva – request for garage (more discussion needed)
Knisley – privacy fence, permit and payment received
Fernau – privacy fence and deck, permit and payments received

Traffic Report –Traffic report emailed to trustees.

Solid Waste/Recycling – Still no recycling bins in town. Ostrander to talk to Waste Connections to see if they would provide service to the village. Clerk to contact Dane Refuse regarding containers as well. Questions of whether we will need to separate recycling if picked up by either, also need for cameras to monitor who abuses the service. Fines could be sent to offenders.

Street, Water, Sewer Report – George talked to Sargent Drilling about communication to and from wells, may need to raise the antenna. Pankoke to work on alleys in November/December. George to contact and verify.

Clerk report – working on water bills and Cross Connection surveys. Residential water no longer taxable. Reported that village attorney is announcing his retirement. Clerk to reach out to Kent Rauert to see if his office would cover additional needs of village. Clerk working on updating forms and accessibility on village website. Also, finishing required CE hours for Municipal Treasurers.
