
VILLAGE OF GOEHNER

May 5, 2020

The Village of Goehner Board of Trustees met in open and regular session on May 5, 2020, at the Goehner Fire Hall, as posted in three places in the Village. Chairperson Knisley announced the location of the OPEN MEETINGS ACT POSTER. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Knisley at 7:40 p.m., at the Goehner Fire Hall. Upon roll call, the following of the board members were present: Ostrander, Besse and Knisley.

CONSENT AGENDA: Minutes of 4/7/2020; Treasurer's Report; Bills payable to date; Trustee Ostrander moved to approve the consent agenda, with second by Besse. No discussion. RCV: Aye-Trustee Ostrander, Besse and Knisley. Motion carried. Dodson arrived at 7:45.

SARGENT DRILLING/JEO: Proposal for north well. George spoke with Sargent Drilling them a few days ago. They have almost acquired all the material needed to begin with the project.

TRAFFIC REPORT: Traffic report sent by Wambold to board via email.

SPRAYING WEEDS: Ostrander asked that the weeds not be sprayed in the ditch by her house and that they will maintain it as yard.

CATTLE OPERATION EAST OF THE VILLAGE/JON EBERSPACHER: Clerk to contact attorney about status of letter that was sent to Eberspacher.

HAZARDOUS MITIGATION: Nothing to report.

ZONING: Two building permits for fences in town. Middleton & Hoeft. 6ft fence height restriction in village limits.

A grain bin was put up on property within village jurisdiction. Clerk directed to contact land owner to apply for a building permit and pay the fee associated with it.

NUISANCE PROPERTY: Frances street residence is still messy. Numerous unlicensed vehicles on street. Certified letter to be sent.

Recycling area has been very messy the past few weeks. A lot of time was spent picking up trash that had blown away. Board to consider adding restriction about non residence use of dumpsters and adding a security camera. A new sign stating restriction and potential fine associated should be installed.

SOLID WASTE RECYCLING: Next meeting scheduled for 6/25/20. Clerk needs to submit expenses associated with recycling 2 weeks before meeting for their review.

STREET WATER SEWER: George reported that the septic is very full. Be cautious of next rain. Mower and tractor have a lot of hours on them. George suggested replacing or trading them in. George to contact dealer and get prices for purchase or trade in.
